Our Commitment

Modbury Soccer Club Inc. is committed to providing a safe environment for the participation of children and young people. Part of this is ensuring that children and young people are not left alone before or after training or games.

Purpose

To ensure that children and young people are not left alone before or after training or games.

What We Will Do

- Make sure parents/guardians and children know the time and location of training and games.
- Request coaches and other Club officials to arrive before scheduled training or game times.
- Give coaches a register of parent/guardian emergency contact numbers and make sure they have access to a phone.
- Encourage the parents/guardians for all U6 U12 children to remain present during all training sessions and games.
- Where a parent/guardian is not present to collect a child or are late, coaches will try to make contact with them and remain with the child until the parent/guardian is present.
- Under **no** circumstance will children be left un-supervised after training or games.
- If the parent in non-contactable and has not returned 30 minutes after the end of the training session / game, South Australian Police will be contacted.
- Junior Coaches are instructed to never be alone with a child under any circumstances. Another adult or club official must always be present.

What We Ask You To Do

- Pick your children up on time or make other arrangements.
- Inform the coach about any changes in arrangements for picking up your child.
- Be responsible for your child before scheduled training, as they are not being supervised by the Club.

Non Compliance

Parents or guardians who repeatedly leave children at training or games, where the coach has to wait for them will be reported to the committee and may face disciplinary action. The Modbury Soccer Club expects parents/guardians to act responsibly at all times.
