



Player Responsibilities and Code of Conduct

In playing with Modbury Soccer Club, which is a member of the Football Federation SA, a player accepts responsibility for complying with the code of conduct detailed below. That player also agrees to the consequences of any breach of the code of conduct. These may include, depending on the nature and severity of the breach:

- Sitting out a match on the substitutes bench
- Removal from the field of play
- Fine, suspension or expulsion from Modbury Soccer Club
- Fine or suspension by the FFSA
- And/or legal proceedings - civil or criminal for conduct unlawful under State or Federal law

Please read the CODE OF CONDUCT carefully and sign the statements below

Whilst performing their duties as members of a team associated with the Football Federation SA, Modbury Soccer Club players will, as well as adhering to the Regulations of Football Federation SA and Football Federation Australia:

1. Attend/participate in all sanctioned FFSA Cup and State League matches, as specified by the coaching staff.
2. Attend/participate in all sanctioned Friendly or Trial matches, as specified by the coaching staff
3. Attend all required Training Sessions including the Pre-Season Conditioning Program
4. If injured, to attend training sessions for assessment and/or rehabilitation of the injury by the club trainer.
5. Advise the Coaching staff by phone or in person if unable to attend required training sessions.
6. Attend all designated Official Club Functions and after-match Presentations in Clubrooms
7. Actively participate in the Club's Junior Coaching and Mentoring program.
8. Behave in an appropriate manner at all times and in accordance with the Modbury Soccer Club, Football Federation SA, and Football Federation Australia codes of conduct.
9. Not engage in any activities that would, in the Club's opinion, detract from or conflict with your performance as a Modbury player. This includes, but is not limited to, coaching, playing or performing any official duties at any other soccer club.
10. Be responsible for costs such as registrations, club memberships and any FFSA fines incurred.
11. Whether before or after leaving your participation as a player with the club, use or disclose to any person any confidential information relating to the Club or its operations.
12. Respect and follow the directions of Modbury coaching staff, match and club officials.
13. Act respectfully toward the players, officials and spectators of opposing Clubs.
14. Act respectfully towards match officials at all times and make no detrimental statements with respect to their performance (e.g. referees/linesman). Abusive language is unacceptable.
15. Avoid individual or collective behaviour, which may reasonably be held by spectators or officials to be offensive or disorderly.
16. Make no derogatory statements in any public forum with respect to any player or official of the Modbury Soccer Club as well as any policy decisions of the Club and its Executive committee.
17. Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing Clubs, and be held financially responsible for any damage they have personally inflicted.
18. Take notice that violent behaviour towards any player, match or Club official or spectator is at all times unacceptable and renders a player liable to serious consequences, as is any sexual, racial and other form of harassment, as described in the Harassment Policy of the FFSA.
