### A STRONG HISTORY

Modbury Soccer Club – also known as The Jets – has a proud football history dating back to 1964.

A member of the Football Federation of South Australia (FFSA), Modbury Soccer Club is committed to the development of football skills, encouraging good sportsmanship, physical fitness, positive team play and the enjoyment of the game according to FIFA rules.

Modbury's junior teams compete in the state's elite junior football competition known as the Junior Premier League (JPL). Where the numbers permit, Modbury Soccer Club also fields teams in the Junior State League (JSL).

### WHAT ARE OUR RULES?

All players registered with Modbury Soccer Club are required to sign a Club Code of Conduct form. In doing so, all players & parents agree to abide by the Code of Conduct policy which outlines the acceptable behaviour of players, parents, etc and the need to respect FFSA officials, Club officials (including coaches), players/parents from your own team and those from opposing clubs.

Players are members of the Modbury Soccer Club first and foremost and while they will a member of a team, it is possible that they will be asked on occasion to play for a different team, for example to provide opportunities for development or to fill in temporarily in the event that a team is short of numbers.

The FFSA also has a “Spectator Code of Conduct” that parents must comply with. Any abusive or disruptive behaviour from a parent or spectator will see them asked to leave the grounds.

## WHERE AND WHEN DO WE PLAY!

In 2017 Modbury's junior teams will play at either Jet Park, corner of Milne and Golden Grove Roads Ridgehaven, or at Burragah Reserve, Alexander Avenue, Modbury North.

Generally junior matches are played on Sunday mornings, however there may be times when junior teams will play at Jet Park on Saturday mornings. This is dependent on the scheduling of matches and availability of pitches.

Teams with a Skillaroos squad in their league will play these games mid-week.

## PLAYER SELECTION

All successfully selected players must attend Junior Registration Day to pay deposit, and complete playing kit sizings. Please refer below for dates and times.

## SUPPORTING YOUR TEAM!

During the season, each team is required to provide:

### Under 12-17

- A Linesman/Assistant Referee at **all** matches.
- A Ground Marshall for **all** matches.

### Under 9-11

- A Ground Marshall for **all** matches.

It is also a requirement that parents help and support their coach/team where necessary such as putting up and taking down of goals/nets, etc.

Parents are also required to support the club with any fundraising events it holds throughout the season, and to volunteer to assist with the Canteen and BBQ.

These are the conditions to register to play for Modbury Soccer Club in 2017.
